Dock Hours

The IBEX Docks will officially be open all three days of the show during show hours, but you will not be constrained by the exhibit hall hours.

Move In and Move Out:

Please bring sufficient mooring lines and bumpers to secure your boat(s). Each vessel will have a port or a starboard finger pier to tie off to. Finger piers are shared between exhibitors to facilitate boarding and securing vessels. The show staff reserves the right to adjust your location in the show should it become necessary.

Directions to launch area from I-275:

- . Take exit 45A toward Downtown W. Follow signs for Tampa Street and merge onto N. Tampa St.
- . Turn right onto E. Kennedy Blvd. Turn left onto S. Hyde Park Avenue.
- . Take the ramp to Davis Blvd. Keep right at the fork, follow signs for Davis Islands
- . Slight right onto Davis Boulevard, keep right at the fork, slight left onto S Davis Blvd
- . At the traffic circle, take the exit onto Severn Avenue.
- . Continue straight onto Martinique Avenue. Martinique becomes turns right and becomes Severn Ave.
- . Ramp Address (Approximate): 801 Severn Avenue, Tampa, FL 33606 (south end of Martinique Ave)

Rate: \$60/day per space needed

Insurance: \$1,000,000 in liability insurance is required for Sea Trials. A certificate of insurance should be provided by each exhibitor.

Power:

Your dock exhibit fee includes a 30 amp service. Note that exhibitors should bring a splitter to reduce from 50 amp to 30 amp if necessary. Additional shore power is available but will need to be contracted through the Edlen Electrical Service Order. Please be sure bring your own molded electrical "Y" connector(s).

Tents:

Small pop-up tents are allowed on the main walkway of the docks by your boat display. Tents should not block any other boat display and no furnishings/other items are allowed to block the main walkway. You are not allowed to drill or nail any items into the docks. Please plan accordingly for weighing down your tent. The show staff reserves the right to request that any tents be moved or taken down if deemed necessary.

Security:

IBEX Show management will provide basic security for the duration of the show, beginning with the designated move-in time through move-out. All dock exhibitors are required by contract to have insurance for any loss or damage that may occur before, during or after the show. Neither IBEX nor the show contractors will be responsible for the loss or damage of product before, during or after the show, including theft.

Speed & No Wake Zones:

IBEX dock exhibitors are reminded to abide by the rules governing the local waterways to and from the dock exhibit areas, especially in regard to “no wake zone” rule around the in-water display docks.

Open Water Sea Trails

For exhibitors who wish to exceed the 5 mph no wake zone, there are two options for leaving the Tampa Convention Center Docks.

The No Wake Zone is approximately 10 minutes for option 1 & 15 minutes option 2.

Option 1- Depart TCC docks and idle under the Harbour Island Bridge towards the port of Tampa. Once your vessel exits the channel normal operating speed can commence into Hillsborough Bay.

Option 2 – Depart TCC docks and idle between Harbour Island (Port Side) and Davis Island (Starboard). After you pass Davis Island normal operating speed can resume in Hillsborough Bay.

Signs:

Signs can be utilized on the vessel and hung from T-tops, Bridges and outriggers

Catering:
